Union Venues

In our bars, Ember Lounge, and Verve we work hard to reduce the environmental footprint of what we do...





Meat free

Buying 5 veggie meals means you get your 6th for free, helping you reduce CO2 from your diet







Disposables and Consumables

We avoid single use plastic – all venues serve drinks in glasses. For takeaway, you'll get compostable packaging and cutlery





Food waste

If there are any leftovers, we make sure to send them to a biogas plant not landfill – producing low-carbon electricity





 Refurbishment When we upgrade our venues, we always make them use less energy. So far, we've saved the equivalent energy of 3 kettles boiling ALL DAY (that's a lot of brews)





Free range eggs

All venues use free range eggs to ensure good welfare for hens producing our food.





Local butchery

We source all our burgers from a Staffordshire butcher to ensure we reduce food miles and support local farms





Fairtrade

We only use Fairtrade tea, coffee and hot chocolate and shops sell Fairtrade products including chocolate and Fairtrade cotton hoodies to ensure better conditions for growers and farmers

Plastic Carrier Bags

We sold over 20000 bags each year and decided to do something about it.

Now using biodegradable bags with the profits from the sale going towards funding our green work

We also sell organic canvas bag alternative designed by students ->->>

We managed to reduce bags to just 5% of shoppers

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Sustainability, Environment and Ethics Policy

Compliance Guidance for Staff

The union continues to support the use of Fairtrade options in our operations

All refreshments provided by the Union for complimentary use will be Fairtrade (tea, coffee, hot chocolate etc.). All tea, coffee & hot chocolate sold in the Union venues will be Fairtrade also.

Retails outlets must stock more than 50% Fairtrade tea, coffee & hot chocolate within the product ranges. From implementation of this policy, the clothing offer in the retail outlets will consist of at least 50% Fairtrade products, aiming to increase this to 100% by 2020.

The Union will continue to expand the range of Fairtrade products for sale in shops and venues and will look to ensure that Fairtrade alternatives are available across as many ranges as possible.

The Union will only use free range eggs in its food from venues and will only stock free range eggs (or those of higher standards) in the retail outlets and will continually look to find higher welfare options when sourcing animal products. The union will explore the use of local food sources as a priority when considering food suppliers.

Continue to reduce office use paper. All purchased paper will be FSC certified or better, as will all copier paper sold in the Union shops.

The union will encourage the use of refillable water bottles at our water fountains

The Union venues will continue to use reusable glassware or plasticware in favour of disposable plastic cups and shops will stock compostable or paper alternatives where possible instead of plastic cups, plates or cutlery.

Venues will continue to use compostable, cardboard or natural alternatives when providing take away boxes and cutlery instead of polystyrene or plastic.

Squeeze box will continue to use plastic alternatives for its smoothie range, take away boxes and cutlery and will continue to pressure and incentivise customers to use reusable cups for their drinks.

Shops will continue to use biodegradable carrier bags and will match or exceed the national carrier bag levy rate regardless of legislation. Profits from the sale of carrier bags will continue to be used to help provide environmental benefits.

All buildings will have instructions for staff on the shutdown of buildings including actions that help reduce energy and water consumption.
